Al-Anon Information Office Phone Volunteer Form and Instructions

Thank you for being willing to be of service by answering phones for the Information Office. Please fill in the date and time you have selected:

Date: _____ Time: _____

At the beginning of your shift you will transfer the office phone to the number of your choice as follows:

- (1) Go to DMRCOM.com
- (2) Go to MY ACCOUNT (4th tab over)
- (3) First tab down – MANAGE YOUR NUMBER
- (4) Log in;
Number (AL anon office business number) 7147481113 (No dash)
Password: welcome (Small case).
- (5) Then go to the Main Dash Board tab. In the bottom right corner it will show SETTINGS. Underneath it says FORWARD (Click this option).
- (6) Check the box that says FORWARD CALL IMMEDIETLY.
- (7) Enter the phone number that you will be using to answer calls in the following format; 1-(XXX) XXX-XXXX.
- (8) Then click APPLY.

When your shift is over, Please cancel the phone forwarding by logging out: Follow steps 1 thru 5, then un-check the box of step 6, skip step 7 and then click Apply.

If you want to preserve your anonymity, you can answer, “Hello” or “Hello, this is (first name).” If the caller wants Al-Anon they’ll either ask or you’ll be able to tell. Most calls are looking for meeting information, so have a directory handy, or print out the directory from www.orangecountyalanon.org. You can also refer them to the website. Sometimes people think we’re AA so give them AA’s OC Central Office Number at 714.556.4555 or 949.582.2697. Other services they can call 211.

Some calls want to know about Al-Anon... how it works, does it cost anything, etc... or want to talk about their situation. Share your experience, strength and hope but remember, the most important thing is to get them to go to a meeting. Occasionally people are in a very tough place, if you ever feel it’s in the best interest, suggest they call 911.
