Since the last Intergroup Meeting H & I has done some additional research regarding court cards.

A company called K.C. Services is church based and is a court ordered service.

K.C. Services serves individuals affected by substance abuse and family violence. They are ordered to attend meetings. The clients are provided a card with a generic list of meetings to attend (AA, CA, NA, Al-Anon) to have signed. The directors and their staff were unaware that Al-Alnon is not a substance abuse program. K.C. Services will remove Al-Anon from their list of support groups. All six of their offices were willing to receive literature regarding Al-Anon Family Groups.

Orange County Courthouse and Downey Courthouse are also misinformed. We will do our best to provide them both with the same information.

The purpose of Public Information and H & I is to inform our communities of the Al-Anon Family Groups.

Please be aware of the cards presented at your meetings and direct those individuals to the correct supporting groups.


World Service Liaison Report to Intergroup Meeting February 18, 2015 Carol G.

PLANNING FOR ASSEMBLY MEETING---The Southern California World Service Area Committee will meet Saturday, February 21, in Glendale to seat a new Board and begin planning for the May 16 Assembly at which Area issues will be discussed and business transacted. Although only designated members may speak or vote at the meetings, any Al-Anon member may attend as an observer.

DISTRICT 66 TOPICS---The South Orange County World Service District has initiated discussion of the differences between roles of World Service Districts and the Orange County/Greater Long Beach Intergroup. The member-education discussions also include information on the differences between the ways the District and the Intergroup use contributions to further Al-Anon work. The education program will include orientation meetings for new District Group Representatives, which will begin at the regular April meeting. An election to fill vacancies on the District Board will be held at that time.

DISTRICT 60 TOPICS---The District's February meeting focused on progress in developing a Web site and on plans for the annual District Workshop. A number of individual Al-Anon members have expressed concern about the workshop because of the featured speaker's long-time identification with the leadership of the four delisted Orange County meetings---meetings removed from the Intergroup Directory because of numerous Traditions-based complaints.
