





- First Spanish Laison meeting took place on April 25th and was a success.
 Spanish Al-Anon groups attended with a total of 12 Al-Anon members. Julie and Cianna attended as well.
- 2. The second Spanish Laison meeting took place on May 23 and unfortunately only 1 member attended due to the Hispanic Intergroup meeting taking place the same day.
- 3. Spanish Al-Anon groups have been invited to the Al-Anon participation at OC Fair. We will be collecting the forms before the deadline.
- 4. The Hispanic Al-Anon/Alateen Convention of Orange County will have English translation on Saturday July 11 from 11:00 am 8:00 pm.

Orange County Intergroup (Serving the Greater Long Beach Area) June 17, 2015, Report from World Service Liaison Carol G.

GOOD NEWS AND BAD NEWS---There was good news and bad news in financial reports at the May Southern California World Service Assembly. The good news is that Southern California income is up and expenses are down, enabling the Area to make a \$5,000 donation to the World Service Office. The bad news is that WSO really needs the money because it is again having to go into reserves to cover its budget, as it has for the last few years. Only about two-thirds of our 15,496 groups contribute to WSO, which has reduced its staff from 76 employees in 1991 to 46 this year. Literature is the main source of revenue for WSO, which made significant reductions in expenses by moving from New York City to Virginia Beach several years ago. By buying office and warehouse space in Virginia instead of renting in New York, the WSO estimates it saved \$673,000 last year alone. Our So Cal Delegate, Elizabeth K., said the 2015 budget deficit could be eliminated if each of the 9,461 groups that do contribute to WSO would donate another \$5.50. Many groups in remote areas are too small to be able to contribute.

FORUM SUBSCRIPTIONS---Members attending the Assembly also learned that subscriptions to The Forum magazine ("a meeting in your pocket") are again declining. When a subscription drop several years ago threatened existence of the magazine, it was a subscription drive in Southern California that saved The Forum.

OPEN TO ALL---Southern California will be host for a March 11-13 Southwest Regional Delegates meeting in La Jolla that will be open to all Al-Anon members. Plans for the meeting that prepares Delegates for the 2016 World Service Conference were announced by our Past Delegate, Jayme C., who said volunteers will be needed to help with the event.

ABOUT YOUR GROUP---There were two announcements at the Assembly that affect reports from your group. One was a request that groups use the Group History Form on the Southern California Web site to add information to the Archives. The other was a report on progress in developing a universal Group Information Update Form that will let groups report changes in officers on one form instead of two. Changes are now reported on one form to Intergroups and another to SCWS and the WSO.

CONFERENCE REPORT---You will hear more about the 2015 World Service Conference when our Delegate, Elizabeth K., speaks at the August Orange County Intergroup meeting.

LOCAL DISTRICT ACTIVITIES---District 57 will present a workshop on conflict resolution this coming Saturday. District 60, which is in a years-long program of mailing Al-Anon literature to local organizations, has launched its Web site, OC Al-Anon-D-60.org. District 63 is completing work on posters it originally planned to use in court facilities to direct people to Al-Anon and now is making available to the Intergroup. District 66 has selected October 10 for its annual workshop with break-out sessions on various Al-Anon topics. Because the District has 60 meetings and wants to ensure that only those eligible to vote at District meetings do so, it has discussed the need to develop a method for identifying eligible voters.
