Financials

- For the month of September 2025, Literature Sales, Group Contributions and Interest Earned totaled \$7,850. Cost of Sales and Operating Expenses totaled \$6,738, resulting in a profit of \$1,112 for the month.
- The new fiscal year started July 1. For the first 3 months of the fiscal year (Jul-Sep), there is a loss of \$3,224. That's compared with a loss of \$2,165 for the same 3-month period last year.
- The balance sheet remains strong with \$16,784 in operating funds, \$103,929 in prudent reserves, and \$35,920 in literature inventory as of September 30, 2025. These add up to total assets of \$156,940. That's compared to total assets of \$158,372 on September 30, 2024. The Information Service has no significant liabilities.
